WHAT TO EXPECT

Build My Future: Driftless Area

Student Safety

At this event, students are encouraged to interact with heavy equipment and other physical activities that assume a certain level of risk. In order to attend, all students must bring a Student-Parent Liability Waiver signed by them and at least one parent or guardian. Signed waivers will be physically turned in on the morning of the event by their teachers at check-in. Students without a signed waiver cannot attend this event.

Students will be provided with various personal protective equipment (PPE) at this event and are **required** to wear them when engaging in any hands-on activities. The Building Futures committee members and the City of Onalaska staff are not responsible for any student injuries preventable through the use of the provided PPE. For students that wear glasses, it is recommended that they bring their own pair of safety glasses that can fit over their regular glasses, or they can request larger safety glasses at the event (as supplies last).

School Arrival & Departure

Students should be **dropped off at the Onalaska Public Works** building by any school buses or vans. Once arrived, a volunteer will escort your school inside to check in and watch the required safety presentation. There will be a designated parking lot nearby for school vehicles to park throughout the event (indicated by directional yard signs).

Students should be **picked up** at the Onalaska Omni Center by school vehicles. There is no time restriction on how long your school is allowed to stay at this event. Typical attendance lasts 3-5 hours, and we ask that all schools depart by 2:00p.m. when the activities conclude. We encourage everyone to explore the exhibits at their own pace.

School Preparation

Prior to the event date, all registered schools will be contacted by our event staff with important event reminders and information to share with your students. Please fully read over the *School Preparation Packet* once it is sent to you, which will be in the form of a Google Doc link for the most up-to-date info.

Photos & Videos

There will be professional videographers and photographers at this event. If any of your students do not wish to have their photo published, please let a volunteer know at check-in. We will provide the student(s) with a sticker to wear that will let our photographers know to exclude them. Please remind these students to have that sticker visible during the entirety of this event.
